

The Fatima Message

trengthening Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus 7th June and the Immaculate Heart of Mary 8th June. The Fatima message, originating from a series of extraordinary events in 1917, has had a profound impact on the Catholic faith, particularly in fostering and strengthening devotion to the **Sacred Heart of**

Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. These apparitions in Fatima, Portugal, delivered a powerful call to prayer, repentance, and devotion that resonates deeply with the core teachings of these two important devotions.

At the heart of the Fatima message is a profound call to reparation and conversion. The Blessed Virgin Mary, during her appearances to the children, emphasised the need for humanity to make reparations for sins and to turn away from sinful ways. This call for repentance echoes the



fundamental aspect of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which emphasises acts of reparation for offences against God's love and mercy. Through prayer, penance, and devotion, both the Fatima message and the Sacred Heart devotion invite believers to reflect on their actions, seek forgiveness, and strive for holiness.

Central to the Fatima message is the importance of prayer, especially the daily recitation of the Rosary. Mary encouraged the children—and, by extension, all believers—to pray the Rosary daily for peace and the conversion of sinners. This emphasis on prayer aligns closely with the devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, which encourages believers to turn to Mary as a loving intercessor

and to seek her maternal guidance through prayer. The Rosary, as a powerful form of prayer, serves as a bridge between devotion to the Immaculate Heart and the Fatima message, uniting believers in a common spiritual practice that deepens their connection to Mary and Jesus.

Furthermore, the Fatima message calls for offering sacrifices and sufferings for the salvation of souls. Mary asked the children to offer their sufferings in union with Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. This concept of redemptive suffering mirrors the teachings of the Sacred Heart devotion, which emphasises the salvific power of Jesus' suffering and encourages believers to unite their own sufferings with His for the redemption of souls. By embracing and offering their sufferings, believers not only participate in the mystery of Christ's sacrifice but also contribute to the spiritual well-being of others, embodying the spirit of love and selflessness central to both devotions.

The apparitions at Fatima also served to promote Marian devotion, particularly under the title of the Immaculate Heart. Mary's messages at Fatima reinforced the importance of turning to her Immaculate Heart for protection, guidance, and intercession. This promotion of Marian devotion aligns seamlessly with the devotion to the Immaculate Heart, which venerates Mary's pure and loving heart as a model of virtue and a source of grace and consolation for believers. Through devotion to the Immaculate Heart, Catholics deepen their relationship with Mary, seeking her help in their spiritual journey and entrusting themselves entirely to her care

Moreover, the Fatima message emphasised the virtues of love, humility, purity, and obedience to God's will. Mary's messages to the children urged them—and by extension, all believers—to live according to the Gospel teachings, to practice acts of charity and selflessness, and to remain faithful to God even in the face of trials and difficulties. These virtues are central to both the Sacred Heart and Immaculate Heart devotions, which encourage believers to emulate the love, purity, and obedience exemplified by Jesus and Mary.

In conclusion, the Fatima message has played a vital role

in strengthening devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary within the Catholic Church. Through its call to prayer, reparation, conversion, and virtuous living, the Fatima message aligns closely with the core teachings and spiritual practices of these devotions, fostering a deeper spiritual connection among believers and inviting them to embrace the love, mercy, and guidance of Jesus and Mary in their lives.

Report on the Retreat for Confirmation Students

An Enriching Experience

n 26th April, we the confirmation children of St. Catherine of Alexandria Parish, Old Goa, were all set, to begin our confirmation retreat at Pilar Pilgrim Centre. Fr. Elvis our retreat coordinator had planned out the full program of the retreat and guided us all throughout the 3 days retreat. The first session by Fr. Hilario Fernandes was on, how God loves us no matter what, and we are all his creations. Following this we had a session with Fr. Joseph Fernandes on increasing our faith in God. Evening was a wonderful walking experience in the nature guided by Ms. Tallulah D'silva. She enriched us about different types of plants, its uses, it properties in our day to day life. She explained in detail about the salt pans and Khazans, at Batim. She highlighted on how our ancestors used various methods for rain water harvesting in the Khazan areas. After a long day out we had another session by Fr. Hilario on significance of Sacraments in our lives as Christians, which we need daily.

The second day of the retreat began with a meditation organized by Fr. Elvis, followed by the celebration of the Eucharist by Fr. Hilario with the theme as the Holy Trinity. Post breakfast we proceeded for a session on Importance on confession in our lives followed by a session by Fr. Elvis on Healthy Social Media practices in our lives and how much creative time we need to spend on the media. Post lunch, Ms. Elaine Coelho spoke on how to strengthen faith in God as a teenager. The next on the list was a visit to the seminary wherein we had a chance to visit the museum and later to the chapel wherein Fr. Peter D'mello briefed about the altar which was built two years before the 2nd Vatican wherein priests during those days face towards the altar and their back towards us. We were later guided to the terrace where we enjoyed the wonderful view of the Zuari Bridge, Siridao, Kundaim Industrial estate, the Arabian Sea, the Zuari River. After returning and having a nice shower Fr. Elvis through his session explained the importance of gratitude in our day to day life, followed by a Holy Hour to meditate in silence. We then proceed outdoors for a rosary and a bonfire that was guided by Fr. Lionel and Ms. Minisha who gave her own testimony and how Jesus touched her spiritually and how she came close to God and dedicated herself to the Divine Youth Group.

On the $3^{\rm rd}$ and the final day we commenced our day by attending the Eucharistic celebration at the Pilar monastery followed by a session by Dr.

Nelly De Sa on "Challenges as an Adolescent". Subsequently we had a session by Fr. Caji Baretto. Fr. Elvis further guided us on how to discover our strengths and qualities and gave us activities to understand the same. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Nicole and Mr. Jayden who thanked Fr. Elvis for being patient with us and helping us give a good formation as we receive Confirmation.

Marian Procession — 13th May 2024: A Report

ur Lady of Fatima is one of the most revered apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Catholic Church.

The feast of Our Lady of Fatima marks the date she first appeared to three shepherd children Lucia dos Santos and her cousin Jacinta Marto and Francisco Marto in Fatima, Portugal, in 1917. The messages delivered during these apparitions included a call to repentance, prayer, and devotion to the Immaculate Heart of

Mary.

The parishioners of St Catherine of Alexandria were anxiously waiting for the day of 13th May 2024 being the feast of Our Lady of Fatima and moreover for the



procession where the statue of Our Lady would visit each somudai and seek her blessings.

Preparation were on in every somudai to welcome the statue of our Lady of Fatima and the somudai members decorated the spot of gathering where 'Fatima Saibin' would visit them. The somudai representatives were allotted with liturgy to be read during the visit along with reciting a decade of the Rosary.



The procession began with a prayer at 5.00 pm at Se Cathedral Church entrance. The Parish Priest Fr. Rosario Oliveira, Assistant Parish Priest Fr. Seby Vaz and a team of Parishioners



started the journey from the church at 5.20pm. As per the schedule as announced earlier the Procession visited each and every somudai.


Report on the Feast of Pentecost Sunday


